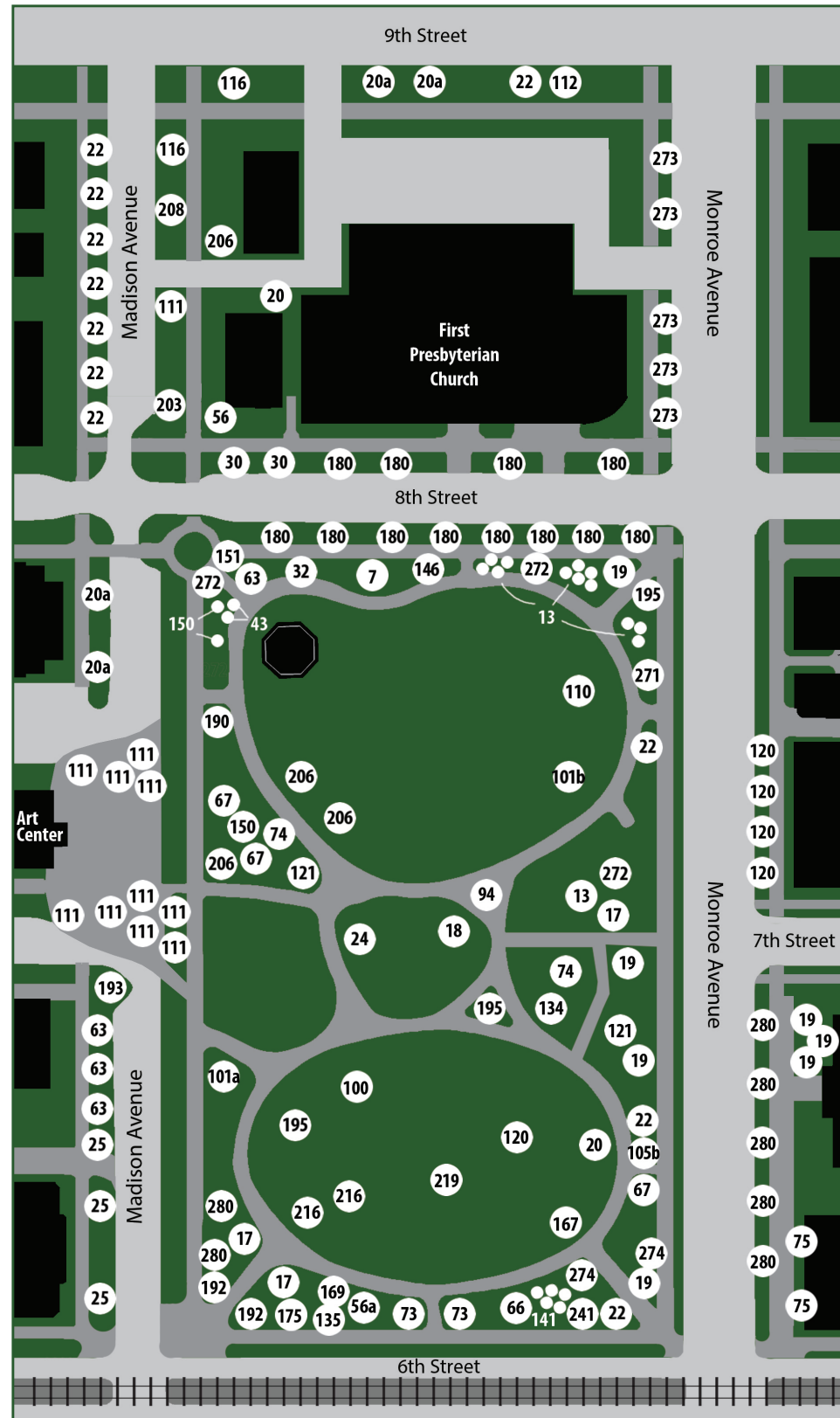

What do CBUF committee members do?

Civic Beautification and Urban Forestry Department Advisory Committee (CBUF) members are citizen volunteers who advise the Department of Parks and Recreation staff on matters relating to community trees and landscape beautification on City-owned land and the community at large.

The committee works to improve the overall health of community trees and landscapes through the promotion of neighborhood and civic projects and education.

Committee members create programs and implement projects that improve public awareness and demonstrate the relationships between people and plant communities, landscapes and trees.
